A common complain amongst those with low vision is difficulty in recognizing faces and emotions. Despite this, when compared to other areas of research (such as reading), there is relatively little research that has explored face perception within individuals with low vision. In this conference, I will describe the previous research in this area. I will also describe research conducted at the MAB to investigate emotion detection and classification, and see if techniques commonly used in rehabilitation can be used to improve performance in these tasks.
