#### Academic context:

- Stipend of \$30 000 for 9 months, and 1500\$ for travel. Possibility of extension of the fellowship upon obtaining funding from external source.
- Possibility to work in Sherbrooke (Campus de la santé, Université de Sherbrooke) or Montreal (McGill University). However, the fellow will be asked to travel periodically between both places.
- Integration of a multidisciplinary team and a national network of researchers in health sciences education.
