Let's revisit post-stroke spatial neglect

Tatiana Ogourtsova received her undergraduate training in Occupational Therapy at McGill University, School of Physical and Occupational Therapy (SPOT).

She worked as a clinician and a clinical coordinator at the Montreal Neurological Hospital/Royal Victoria Hospital of the McGill University Health Centre (MUHC). She has a Masters (Thesis) and a PhD in Rehabilitation Science, both completed at SPOT and CRIR—Jewish Rehabilitation Hospital, in the field of post-stroke visual neglect and use of virtual reality. She is passionate about evidence-based practice and is the lead author of nearly 20 Stroke Engine (www.strokengine.ca) knowledge translation modules.

Currently, she is engaged in her second postdoctoral fellowship at the RIMUCH, under the supervision of CRIR member Annette Majnemer, in the field of childhood disability and health services/patient-oriented/knowledge translation research.

Post-stroke visual neglect is a highly prevalent, disabling, heterogeneous and a complex disorder. This workshop aims to review important concepts in the field of post-stroke spatial neglect: epidemiology, underlying theories, past & current clinical practice challenges, evidence-based practice guidelines, and emerging methods along with the latest research. Participants will be offered important resources that can be directly implemented in their clinical practice. This is in part an interactive session, where participants will be asked to engage in different reflective activities to consolidated their knowledge and awareness about the subject.
